VIII. ANALYSIS AND INTERPRETATION




Chart: 1 Usage of Smart Phone

respondents 37(74%) respondents are using the Smart phone; 13(26%) respondents are not using the smart phone. Among 50 respondents many of the students are using the smart phone.




Chart: 2 Spending time on the usage of Smart Phone




Chart: 3 Use of other Functions in Smart Phone




Chart: 4 Amount spend for using Smart Phone services




Chart: 5 Spending a day without using Smart phone
