National Service Scheme - Special Camp Report

Units VII & VIII – Endapulli Panchayat

20th – 26th November, 2018

The National Service Scheme of Jayaraj Annapackiam College for Women (Autonomous), Periyakulam organized a special camp at **Endapulli Panchayat** of Periyakulam Taluk, Theni Dt. from 20.11.2018 to 26.11.2018. The theme of the special camp was “**GREEN INDIA IS IN THE HANDS OF YOUTH**”. 100 NSS volunteers from the NSS Units VII and VIII, Programme Officers and Staff Advisors participated in the camp. The camp organizers **Dr. Sr. S. Jesurani**, Principal, J. A. College, **Dr. Sr. B. J. Queensly Jeyanthi**, Mother Superior and Secretary, J.A. College and NSS Coordinator of J. A. College Sr. S. Jothi planned and coordinated the special camp.

20.11.2018

The special camp was inaugurated by **Dr. Sr. S. Jesurani, Principal, J. A. College**. The inaugural function was presided by **Mr. Subburaj, Panchayat Leader**, Endapuli. Dr. M. Kalanithi, Associate Professor in Chemistry & NSS Programme Officer of Unit VIII, J. A. College welcomed the gathering. Dr. Sr. B. J. Queensly Jeyanthi, Mother Superior and Secretary, J. A. College rendered the felicitation. The NSS volunteers presented a skit on the theme **Clean India** and **Tree plantation**. Selvi Divyadharshini, NSS Volunteer gave an inspiring speech about Women Education. Dr. D. Selvi, Assistant Professor in Mathematics and NSS Programme Officer of Unit VII proposed the vote of thanks.





Everyday activities started with the prayer followed by field work. The volunteers cleaned the surroundings of Sri. Markandeya Primary School, Endapuli.

In the first day of the camp, “**Dengue Fever and Swine Flu: Awareness and Treatment**” was given by **Mr. Bhavanandam, Block Medical Officer, Periyakulam**. Students went in groups and gave awareness to the people. Nilavembu Kasayam was distributed to the villagers and volunteers. Volunteers emphasized the villagers about “**Clean India**”, proper sanitation at each house and informed about the financial support given by the Government for construction of individual toilets.



Open defecation Free Survey was taken by volunteers.

Rally on “clean India” was flagged by Mr. Subburaj, Panchayat Leader and volunteers went on to all streets of the village informing the importance of cleanliness towards good health.

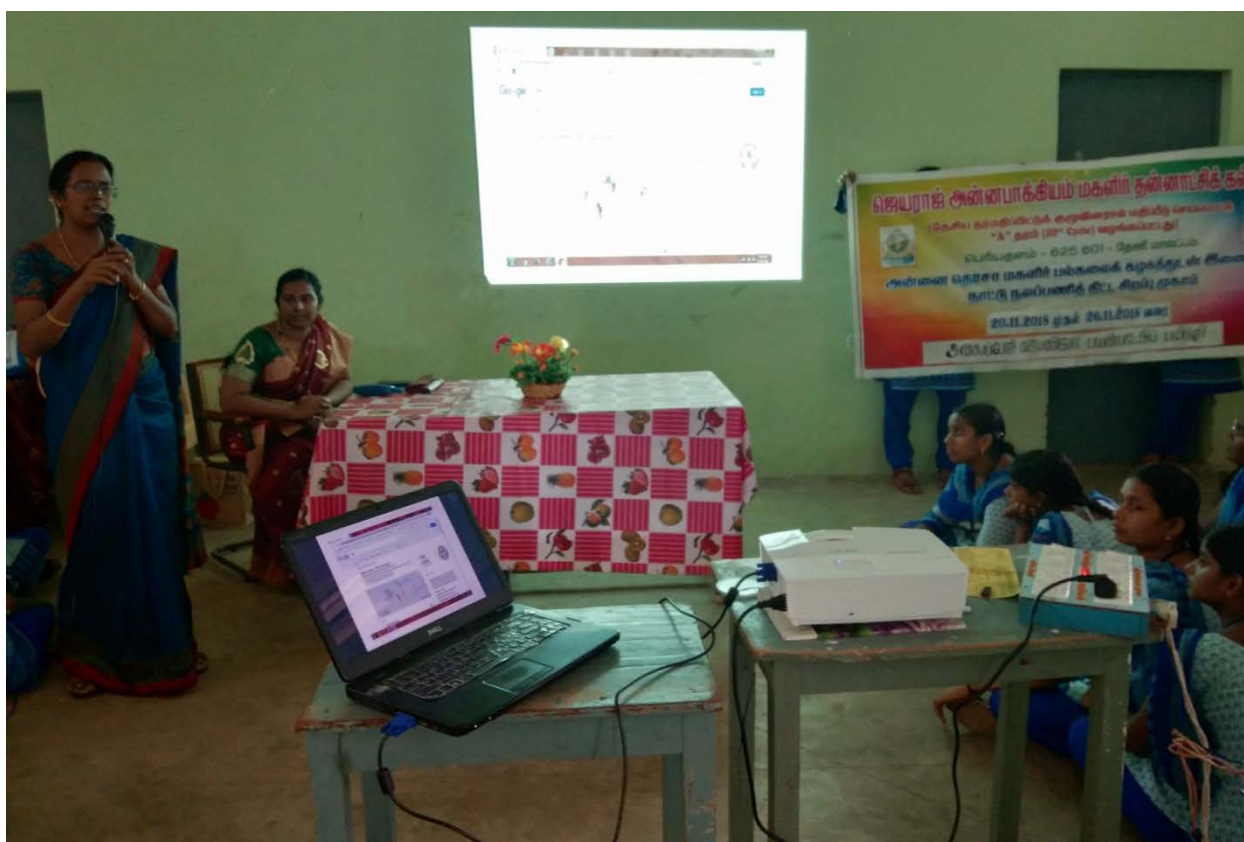


Games were conducted for girls of 13-20 age group and prizes were distributed by the Principal.

21.11.2018

Training on Online Transaction and Payment of Bills and Premium was demonstrated by **Dr. M. Kalanithi, NSS Programme officer** and Associate Professor of Chemistry.

Survey about the basic amenities available in each home was taken by the NSS volunteers. NSS volunteers presented cultural programmes on the theme **“Pros and Cons about using Mobile Phones”**.



Games were conducted for girls of 20 to 30 age group and prizes were distributed by the Programme Officers.

22.11.2018

Programme on **“Eradication of Parthenium Plants”** was organized. **Dr. M. Kalanithi** explained the harmful effects of parthenium plant to human beings and animals. The plants were removed completely in and around Sri Markandeya primary school, Endapulli. Students removed the plants by using

gloves and spilled salt water on the plants and informed the toxic effects of getting hot foods in the polythene covers.



In the afternoon, a talk on **Application of Mobile App** was given by Dr. Ms. A. Anita Mary, Assistant Professor of Zoology.

Games were conducted for women and prizes were distributed. NSS volunteers presented cultural programmes on the theme **“Harmful Effects of using Plastic and Polythene Materials”**. The movie **“Aram”** was screened to the volunteers and the people.



23.11.2018

The theme of the third day programme was “**Self Employment for Women**”. Sr. T. Johny Dathees, Assistant Professor of Chemistry, J. A. College for Women, Periyakulam gave training on **Preparation of Phenoyl, Washing Powder and Cleaning Powder** to the NSS volunteers and the public. The training paves the way for entrepreneurship.



Mr. Chandru, Drawing Master, Theni gave training on **Wall Paintings** related to Swatch Bharat for NSS volunteers and school students. **Survey about the basic amenities** available in each home was taken by the NSS volunteer. NSS volunteers organised competitions for married men and distributed the prizes.



24.11.2018

The fourth day programme was organised on the theme “**Cleanliness**”. **Free General Medical Camp** was conducted by **Dr. R. R. Anumanthan**, M.B.B.S., MD.P.G.DIP.DIAP., MESAP TRUST, Periyakulam. 70 public were benefitted out of it.

25.11.2018

Science Exhibition based on the basic concepts in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Zoology was organised by NSS volunteers to school students. It was very useful for the students to enrich their knowledge. It was organized by NSS programme officers and staff advisors.



Seed Balls were prepared by NSS students using different plants like neem, Tamarind, Pungai and sowed in different places in the village. **Tree saplings** were distributed by the volunteers to the people of E. Pudupatti.

26.11.2018
