The theme of the special camp was "INVOLMENT OF YOUTH TOWARDS GREEN INDIA". NSS volunteers from the NSS Units 9th & 10th, NSS Programme officers and Staff Advisors participated in the camp.

DAY-1: TUESDAY (20.11.2018)

The special camp was inaugurated by **Dr. Sr. B. J. Queensly Jeyanthi,** Secretary, J. A. College and Mother Superior of St. Anne's Convent, **Mrs. A. Mallika, RLF Leader, A. Meenachipuram by lighting the Kuthuvilaku**. The inaugural function was presided by **Dr. Sr. S. Jesurani, Principal,** Jayaraj Annapackiyam College for Women (Autonomous), Periyakulam. J. DAY-2: Wednesday (21.11.2018)

Miss. Poornalaxhmi, Assistant professor of Chemistry, Jayaraj Annapackiam College for Women (Autonomous), Periyakulam, demonstrated the preparation of **Candle, Phenoyl, Detergent Powder and Soap Oil** to the villagers and NSS volunteers. Around 150 villagers were benefitted and also motivated to become entrepreneurs.

DAY-3 Thursday (22.11.2018)

Survey about the basic amenities available in each home was taken by the NSS volunteers.

DAY-5 Saturday (24.11.2018)


