This was highly valuable extracurricular activities. This project was handled by our staff member Mrs. M. Nithya, Assistant Professor of Commerce with Computer Applications. We bought the needed materials from the seed Capital for making the Door mat. The student brought the old cotton saree individually and the preparation of doormat making has been taught to the two students from each class(1st, 2nd and 3rd year). The six students from 1st, 2nd and 3rd year selected and these students learned the doormat preparation and taught to their class. After giving the training all the students did the doormat by using old clothes. They sold the doormat on the basis of

quality. Totally 217 students (I Year-83, II Year-72, III Year-62) are participated in this programme. The profit amount get from this project is utilized for paying the exam fees of poor students.
