

## **EXTENSION REPORT**

### **EDUCATION**

JACEP volunteers of Jayaraj Annapackiam College for Women, Periyakulam visited Jetlur to educate the children of the village with teaching aids on 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2018. The students gave awareness for education by explaining government educational schemes like Women Empowerment in rural areas. Among the children, our students identified a dumb girl and talked with her mother about her problem. For her we arranged to learn tailoring at our institution.

To motivate them, the videos of some achievers like Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam were screened. Education group went to Government Higher Secondary School, Saruthupatti and taught Mathematics problems to the students of standard VII & VIII and cleared their doubts for simple problems and motivated them to study their subjects in an interesting manner on 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2018. 16 of our students went to Jayamangalam on 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 and gathered the children to make know the importance of studies.

## ENVIRONMENT

The students of environment group visited Jayamangalam on 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2018. They interacted with the village people and shared their views to maintain surrounding as neat and clean. They visited each and every house in that area and asked whether they had proper water facility and they suggested them to discard the garbage in the proper place as degradable and non-degradable waste. They requested our students to have the proper sewage system & the regular arrival of the sweepers to maintain the surroundings clean. The students also explained the people to write and give the complaint letters.

The students gave awareness to the rural women about the usage of sanitary napkin disposal on 4<sup>th</sup> October, 2018. They interacted with the children to take bath daily and taught them the importance of trees, the cleanliness of the streets and the toxicity of plastic bags. They got the phone numbers from some home makers and senior citizens for future use. The group collected the details about toilets on 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 and represented to the Panchayat, to build under the government lavatory scheme of 2017-18. According to the government lavatory scheme 2015-16, nearly 12 lavatories were built up but the work was not yet completed. The students referred Mr. Ranga Samy, a farmer in the village about the details of the Panchayat which would be easier to plan our future work.

## PEOPLE ORGANIZATION

The students visited Meenatchipuram and interacted with the village people whether they were aware of the loan schemes provided by the government to improve their life style on 24<sup>th</sup> October 2018. They explained the school and college students about the educational loans. The members of Health & Hygiene gave a speech on healthy environment. They showed some videos to be hygienic.

The students taught the rural women about the basic responsibilities and informed the necessity of saving money on 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 to promote the helping tendency at home and society. The people organization group attended hands on training programme to make Zorthosi products and Hand embroidery



items. They created awareness to be united through short stories and short films at Saruthupatti on 27th October, 2018.

### HEALTH AND HYGIENE

From our College, we conducted a Medical Camp in Jetlur on 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 as a free health care. As a part of our efforts to make basic healthcare, we invited Dr. Manivannan, BAMS, the Siddha doctor of Dhanvantari Clinic, Bodinayakkanur. We provided basic treatment and general check up to help the people be aware of their health status. The doctor found that there were so many persons with skin disease. He provided free medical advice and medicine to the deprived citizens of our rural humanity. The camp made sure that people got the healthcare at the right time. More than 30 patients were benefitted.

The students went to Jayamangalam on 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 and insisted the villagers about personal Health and Hygiene. They requested the children to use public toilets or the toilets in their house. They suggested the women not to use open area for disposing napkins. They suggested them to eat green vegetables and green leaves. They informed them to keep all water containing vessels closed.

The students gave awareness for bathing, brushing, washing and cleaning their houses & surroundings through charts & videos on 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2018. The

children were instructed to eat healthy and fresh food at T. Kallipatti. The students cleaned the weeds around the planted saplings. There was no proper medical facility and the ambulance would arrive there once in 15 days to provide the tablets on 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2018. The villagers suggested having primary Health centre that would be of great help to them on 28<sup>th</sup> October, 2018. They instructed the villagers not to throw the wastes in the road side. They suggested them to eat green vegetables and green leaves.

### LIAISON

There was no President in the village because of the delay in the



Panchayat Board Election on 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2018. The students met a person named K. Kannaiya, the Acting Head at the time. Through him, we know that, no government activity was taken place by any official for the two years. For the name shake, the government appointed Saruthupatti clerk named Manikkam as a chargeship for the village needs on 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2018. But he was not available during our visit. Mr. K.Kannaiya informed us to meet a teacher named K. Suseela, the Incharge for “100 Day Work Scheme”. She said that she could refer the Clerk for our cause. Additionally she said that we had to go to Vadugapatti Union Office for further Clarification. We informed Mr. K.Kannaiya to take further step related with our issue. He promised that he would go and meet the officials at Vadugapatti. We planned our next visit to Vadugapatti to take further step on 27 September, 2018.

The students visited the streets Jayamangalam and asked the people about their toilet facility. Few of them had the facility, that too provided by the government scheme. Even if the people were provided with the toilet facility they were ignorant about it. The village people gave the petition at collecterate of theni district to get the solution for their basic need of toilet facility and water problem.

### **APPLICATION OF KNOWLEDGE**

The students visited Jetlur on 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 to educate the children of the village with teaching aids. They taught the children cursive handwriting by using four line note books and created awareness through charts related to the topics - fruits& vegetables, animals, birds, colours, solar system, ban plastic etc. They trained them spoken English with the help of teaching aids like Roll-up Boards. Flash cards & Visual Aids were used to teach Parts of speech, vowels & question tags.

The students went to Jayamangalam village on 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2018. They gathered the children and taught the importance of studies. They showed some videos to create a well educated country. They taught the village children how to behave with the elders. Moreover they taught them about Swachh Bharat Abiyan. The Students also gave hands on training for the preparation of phenyl and washing powder
