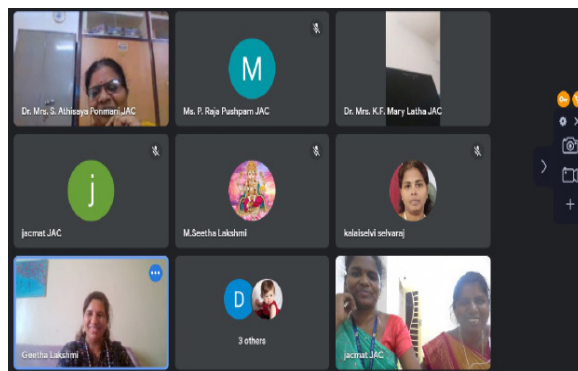

- On account of Diwali Festival, Dr. Sr. S. Jesurani, Principal has distributed new sarees to the deserving students from fourteen departments.



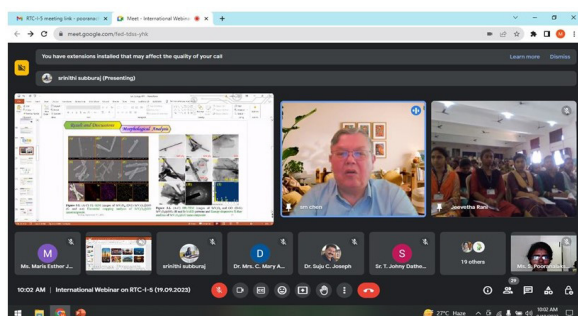

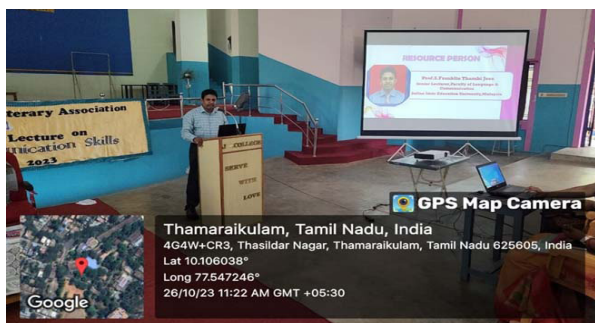
### Reading Club
